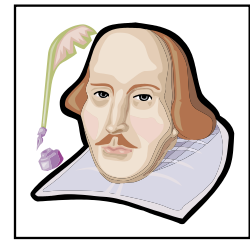

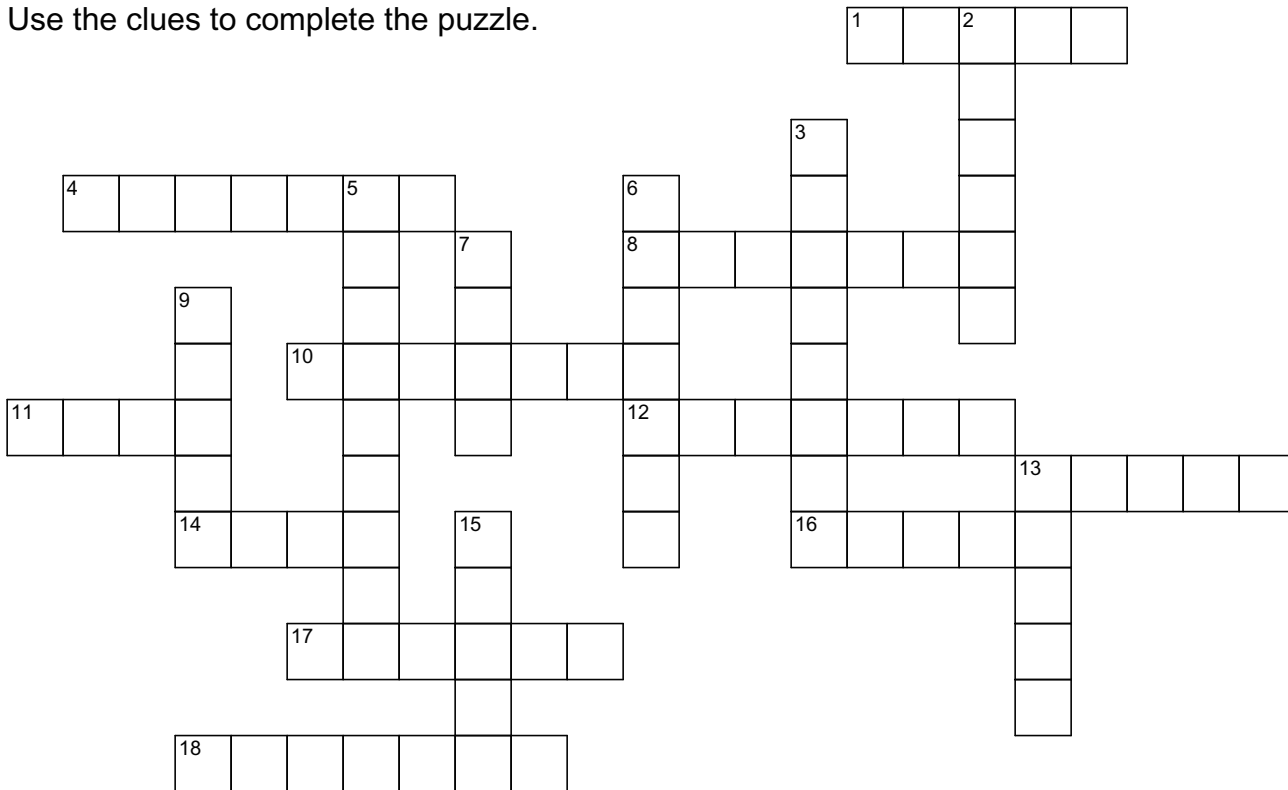

Use the clues to complete the puzzle.

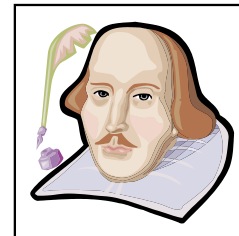
